- A sleeping bag, a sheet and pillow.
- Prescription Medicine must be in its original container and be placed in a clearly marked zip lock bag. It will be given to the camp nurse at check-in.

- BSA Class A Shirt and neckerchief slide. The troop will be giving out new neckerchiefs.
- Troop Class B T-shirt
- BSA Handbook, Notebook and pen(s) &/or pencil(s)
- Money for the trading post and any Handicraft Merit Badges which have a fee

- _____ Shorts
- _____ Long pants (some activities may require long pants)

- _____ Sneakers
- _____ Swimming trunks & towels
